Handbook of International Law. Third Edition. By George Grafton Wilson. St. Paul: West Publishing Co. 1939. Pp. xxiv, 623. \$5.00.

The latest developments in a branch of the law of special interest in a world with strife among nations.

The Judicial Process in Tort Cases. Second Edition. By Leon Green. St. Paul: West Publishing Co. 1939. Pp. xxi, 1356. \$6.00.

A shorter edition more adaptable to courses of study.

Cases on the Law of Trusts. By George Gleason Bogert. Chicago: The Foundation Press, Inc. 1939. Pp. xlvii, 879. \$6.00.

A valuable compilation of leading cases in the law of trusts with latest cases showing modern problems and developments.

Handbook of Admiralty Law in the United States. By Gustavus H. Robinson. St. Paul: West Publishing Co. 1939. Pp. xiii, 1025. \$5.00.

A survey of a special field of the law not usually taken in the law school but knowledge of which may be valuable to the practicing lawyer.

Cases on Wills and Administration. Second Edition. By Philip Mechem and Thomas E. Atkinson. Chicago: The Foundation Press, Inc. 1939. Pp. xvi, 840. \$5.50.

A radical revision of the earlier edition. New cases, rewritten notes, general amplification of materials, and extensive rearrangement results in practically a new book.

Jurisdiction and Practice of the Courts of the United States. Fourth Edition. By Charles W. Bunn. St. Paul: West Publishing Co. 1939. Pp. ix, 257. \$2.00.

A very brief survey of the present system of United States courts, including a discussion of the new Federal Rules.

Cases and Materials on Contracts. Revision of *Cases on Contracts*. Third Edition by George P. Costigan, Jr. By Harold Shepherd. Chicago: The Foundation Press, Inc. 1939. Pp. xxxv, 1215. \$6.50.

The general scope and objective of Costigan's book have been retained. The changes therein have been made to improve its usefulness to a first year class and to include development of contract principles since the earlier edition.
