Justice and the Press. By John Lofton. Boston: Beacon Press. 1966. Pp. xiv, 462. \$5.95.

This book concerns the current problem of journalistic sensationalism and the law. It discusses how the courts must weigh the rights of the accused to a fair trial with the abuses which can result from police and judicial secrecy.

Cases and Materials on Family Law. By Caleb Foote, Robert J. Levy, and Frank E. A. Sander. Boston: Little, Brown, & Company. 1966. Pp. xxv, 1005. \$14.00.

This book provides a very comprehensive treatment of the field of family law.

Social Origins of Dictatorship and Democracy. By Barrington Moore, Jr. Boston: Beacon Press. 1966. Pp. xix, 559. \$10.00.

A documented reassessment of modern political evolution is presented in this book.

Kennedy Campaigning. By Murray B. Levin. Boston: Beacon Press. 1966. Pp. xix, 313. \$5.95.

As the title suggests, this book is concerned with the campaign tactics of a member of the Kennedy family, Edward Kennedy, in his fight to win the Senate seat once held by his brother, John Kennedy.

Sex, Pornography & Justice. By Albert B. Gerber. New York: Lyle Stuart, Inc. 1965. Pp. 349. \$10.00.

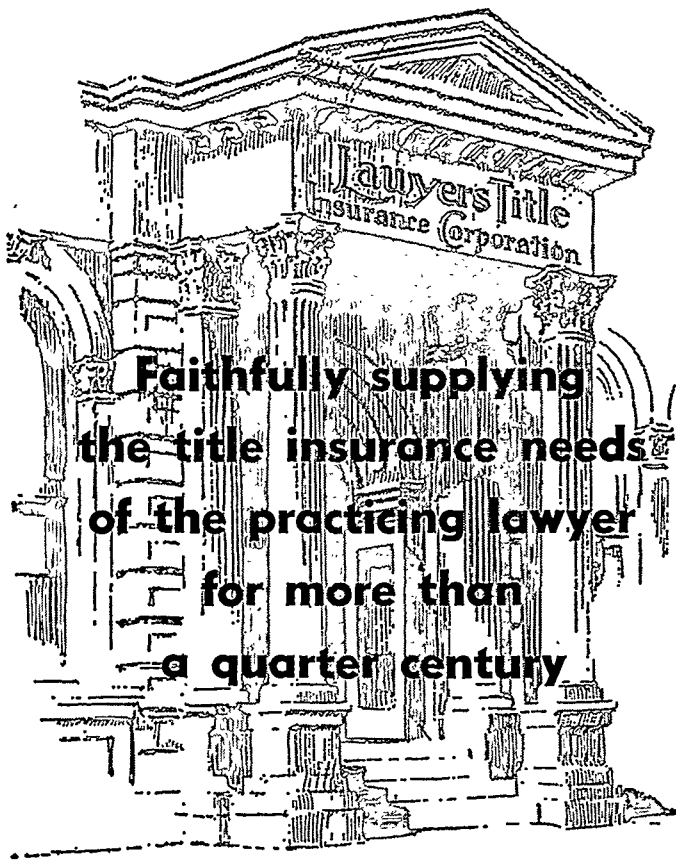
Mr. Gerber presents a study of pornography from the middle ages to modern day.

Socialism and the Workers in Massachusetts, 1886-1912. By Henry F. Bedford. Amherst, Mass.: The University of Massachusetts Press. 1966. Pp. xiii, 315. \$6.50.

This book investigates the Socialist party of Massachusetts from its origins to its timid response to industrial warfare in Lawrence in 1912.

Judicial Control of Administrative Action. By Louis L. Jaffe. Boston: Little, Brown and Company. 1965. Pp. xiv, 792. \$20.00.

The author opens with an introductory discussion of the administrative process and the current controversy surrounding it. He then develops his thesis that the courts and the agencies are partners in law-making and law-applying, showing the interrelationship of courts and agencies.
